The platform, built by Lee Wilson, is located behind the Weatogue Fire Station, 251 Hopmeadow Street (Route 10) in Simsbury, Special thanks to Tuff Shed®, through Home Depot Foundation, for donating an 8' x 8' shed to be placed near the platform for the storage of flags and other VFW and American Legion equipment. Monetary donations for building materials were provided by UNICO National – Avon, CT Chapter, Abigail Phelps Chapter DAR in Simsbury, Aguarion Water Company and the VFW Metacomet Post 1926 and American Legion Tomalonis-Hall Post 84, both of Simsbury. The Retirement of Old Colors ceremony from the Officer's Guide and Manual of Ceremonies of The American Legion was used. Hundreds of flags were honorably retired that day, some coming from attendees.
